**NOTICE OF RECEIPT****PETITION FOR POST-CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE
MARSH LANDING GENERATING STATION (08-AFC-03C)**

On August 13, 2020, NRG Marsh Landing, LLC, filed a Petition to Amend (PTA) with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Marsh Landing Generating Station. MLGS is a simple-cycle, natural gas-fired, 760-megawatt facility, located in the city of Antioch, California. The project was certified by the Energy Commission on August 25, 2010, and began commercial operation on May 1, 2013.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The project owner is requesting changes to Title V conditions of certification related to combustion turbine tuning events.

Staff will also provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposal as a staff approved project change or schedule the project change to be heard for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.
