CALeVIP is funded under the CEC's Clean Transportation Program. CALeVIP maintains an online interface that allows individuals who are interested in installing EV chargers to easily access resources, connect with companies that sell or install chargers, and apply for rebate funding via a simplified application process. To date, CALeVIP has invested \$76.1 million in six active incentive projects. Two additional incentive projects will launch in 2020.
