It appears that Section 1302. Rules of Construction and Definitions. (a) (2) removes the use of "and/or" in Title 20, Chapter 3.

Pursuant to Section 1302. Rules of Construction and Definitions. (a) (2) The use of "and" in a conjunctive position means that all elements in the provision must be complied with, or must exist to make the provision applicable. Where compliance with one or more elements suffices, or where existence of one or more elements make the provision applicable, "or" (rather than "and/or") is used.

Section 1302. Rules of Construction and Definitions. (b)(56) "Premise identification number" means the unique identification number assigned by a utility to a collection of buildings and/or meters serving an individual customer at a contiguous location.
