Subject: Chevron Petition to Remove Limits on Surplus Electric Generation at the Chevron-Richmond Cogeneration Station (86-SPPE-1C)

Gentlemen:

PG&E does not oppose the subject petition by Chevron to the extent that any California Energy Commission ("CEC") decision granting the relief requested by Chevron applies to the Richmond facility's CEC granted operating permit only. The Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) contains delivery restrictions identical to items D and E described in Chevron's petition. Any change to lift such restrictions will require agreement between Chevron and PG&E, in the form of an Amendment or new PPA, which will be subject to the approval of the California Public Utilities Commission.
