



California Energy Commission (CEC) staff will host a remote-access workshop to solicit feedback on a draft solicitation concept for a block grant implementer for light-duty electric vehicle (EV) charger incentive projects. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The Draft Solicitation Concepts will be posted before the workshop on the <u>CEC Docket Log for 20-EVI-01</u> at https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=20-EVI-01. The document details the concepts under consideration for a competitive grant solicitation to be issued by the CEC's Clean Transportation Program.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in these Executive Orders. Instructions for remote participation are below.

Background

Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), created the Clean Transportation Program (formerly known as the Alternative and Renewable Fuels and Vehicle Technology Program). The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. Assembly Bill 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program through January 1, 2024.

Staff is developing a grant funding opportunity that will provide funding from the Clean Transportation Program for a block grant implementer to design and implement light-duty electric vehicle charger incentive projects.

Public Comment

Oral comments will be accepted at the end of the workshop. Comments may be limited to three minutes or less per speaker and one person per organization.
