The California Electric Code should require a single, all electric baseline requirement for all building types immediately and not wait until 2025. All electric buildings are less expensive to build and operate, better for people's health and an absolutely critical part of any strategy that will reduce carbon emissions and protect us from the climate crisis. It makes no sense to have buildings use gas, which is more expensive to build and to operate, when California is not only facing a climate crisis but also a housing crisis.
