On April 30, 2021, Jennifer Merrick provided clarification regarding a technical memorandum (TN 237501) that had been provided regarding withdrawal of a proposal to install desert tortoise fencing at the SEGS III-VII site and a description of how the existing facility fence would be repaired to close any gaps. Staff requested additional information about how the fence gaps would be repaired and if the workers would need to work outside the fence. Ms. Merrick confirmed with NextEra Operations staff that all the work can be completed from inside the fence. No work will occur outside of the fenceline.
