NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Project Title: Small Power Plant Exemption for the Sequoia Backup Generating Facility

Project Location: 2600 De La Cruz Boulevard, Santa Clara, California

Lead Agency: California Energy Commission

County: Santa Clara

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code §21000 et seq.) and the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15000 et seq.), a Revised Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for the above-named project that identifies and evaluates the environmental impacts of the project.

Project Description

The project consists of an application to be exempted from the Energy Commission's jurisdiction to approve the construction and operation of 54 diesel generators to provide backup generation to support the Sequoia Data Center when electricity is unavailable. The generators would not be interconnected to the electric transmission grid.
