Public Notice

Mechanical ATT Requirements for Nonresidential Permits June 28, 2021

Notice to authorities having jurisdiction

The mandatory requirement that any person performing a mechanical systems acceptance test (Title 24, Part 6, Section 120.5) in a nonresidential building must be certified as an acceptance test technician (ATT) by an acceptance test technician certification provider (ATTCP) took effect on April 14, 2021. To allow a reasonable time for training and implementation of additional acceptance test technicians, the California Energy Commission (CEC) expects authorities having jurisdiction (AHJ) to enforce the mechanical systems ATT requirements to all nonresidential permit applications submitted on or after **October 1, 2021**.

Note: Certified ATTs have been required to perform lighting controls acceptance tests (Title 24, Part 6, Section 130.4) for nonresidential construction projects since July 2014.

Enforcement

All [acceptance test documentation](#) requiring an ATT is limited to the nonresidential certificates of acceptance (NRCAs) issued by the ATTCPs with its logo on each page. The NRCAs will be in PDF format for electronic submission to the AHJ.

Outreach and Education

ATTCPs are offering free training for inspectors and building officials. The training will cover ways to verify the legitimacy of the forms and tests.

California Energy Commission is offering a one-hour course as an introduction to the ATTCP program.
