**NOTICE OF RECEIPT****PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE
TRACY COMBINED CYCLE POWER PLANT (08-AFC-07C)**

On June 21, 2021, MRP San Joaquin Energy, LLC, on behalf of Tracy Combined Cycle Power Plant (Tracy) filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC). Tracy is a 330 MW combined-cycle generating facility, consisting of General Electric Model PG 7121 EA natural gas-fired combustion turbine generators. Tracy occupies a fenced 16.3-acre site within a 40-acre parcel in an unincorporated portion of San Joaquin County, southwest of the City of Tracy, approximately 20 miles southwest of Stockton. Tracy was certified by the CEC on March 24, 2010 and commenced commercial operation on November 1, 2012.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

MRP San Joaquin Energy, LLC is seeking approval to construct a temporary laydown yard to accommodate the anticipated increased equipment and personnel needs during the April 2022 major planned outage, for a period of approximately 30-45 days. Tracy plans to setup the laydown area approximately one month prior to the outage and return the area to its current state within a month of the completion of the planned outage.

This Notice of Receipt has been mailed to the facility's mail list of interested parties and to property owners of all parcels within 1,000 feet of the facility site. The petition requesting the project change has been docketed and is available on the CEC's webpage for this facility at:

REVIEW PROCESS

The review process includes an evaluation of whether the change would have a significant effect on the environment, whether the project would continue to comply with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations or standards, and if a change to or deletion of a condition of certification is required.

After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, staff will publish an assessment for public review and comment. Staff will also provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a staff-approved project change or schedule the project change to be heard for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.
