Dear Commissioner McCallister:

King Energy is a next generation energy company focused on bringing clean energy solutions to multi-tenant commercial properties and their tenants. We provide a turnkey solar program, handling all costs and effort associated with program installation and long-term management.

King Energy was founded in late 2020 and our first program, a 250kW rooftop solar array on Acorn Plaza, a shopping center in Santa Maria, will go live within the next few weeks. Through Virtual Net Energy Metering (VNEM), this project will enable 16 businesses who lease space at the center to consume clean energy generated on-site, and reduce their energy expenses by over \$10,000 annually, despite having no ownership of the space and having put no capital investment into the solar project.

King Energy has 45 similar projects throughout California comprising over 9.5MW of solar capacity under development that we expect to reach commercial operation in 2021 and 2022. We have forged strong relationships with commercial property owners and developers who are very excited about our program offering, and the fact that allows multi-tenant commercial property owners and their tenants to participate in the solar revolution.

We are well-positioned to implement any multi-tenant commercial solar and storage requirements for new construction that the California Energy Commission may enact.
