2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR): Request for Extension of Time to File
Certain Electricity Demand Forecasts

Dear Licha Lopez:

This letter is in response to your June 3, 2021, request to extend the filing deadline for Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) to submit Electricity Demand Forecast forms required by the California Energy Commission (CEC) in support of the *2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (2021 IEPR)*. The CEC adopted detailed instructions describing the scope and timing of required data submissions at a business meeting on May 12, 2021.

PG&E seeks an extension from June 30, 2021 to July 30, 2021 to submit all components of Electricity Demand Forecast forms 1, 2, 3, and 4. The extension would accommodate PG&E's intention to revise its forecast in response to a recent proposed decision published by the CPUC.

Noting that form 8 builds on information provided in form 1, PG&E seeks an extension from June 30, 2021 to August 31, 2021, to submit Electricity Demand forms 8.1a and 8.1b.

I appreciate that PG&E wants to submit data of the highest quality and find that good cause exists for the extensions.

In accordance with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1342(c), I grant the request for extending the deadlines to submit Electricity Demand Forecast forms 1.1a through 4 and the Electricity Demand forms 8.1a, and 8.1b.
