<u>Legislation</u>

SB 423 (Stern) Energy: renewable and zero-carbon resources. Amended 7/13. A-APPR.

Suspense. This bill requires the CEC, in consultation with the CPUC, CAISO, and CARB, by 12/31/2022, to submit to the Legislature an assessment of emerging renewable energy and firm zero-carbon resources that support a clean, reliable, and resilient electrical grid. This bill aims to accelerate procurement of renewables to existing CPUC procurement requirements to ensure a reliable grid especially during extreme weather events. States in the findings and declarations that California is a global leader in solar energy and lithium-ion battery storage deployment, and these resources are increasingly and urgently needed to boost grid reliability.

SB 551 (Stern). California Zero-Emission Vehicle Authority. 7/8 version. A-APPR. Suspense.

This bill establishes the California Zero-Emission Vehicle Authority within the Governor's office to coordinate activities to advance the deployment electric vehicle charging and zero-emission fueling infrastructure and ensure equity, workforce, and economic development. One of many responsibilities for the Authority is to support and improve the battery supply chain including the use of lithium from the Salton Sea.
