## ORDER SHORTENING TIME ON APPLICANT'S MOTION IN LIMINE

### BACKGROUND

On March 19, 2020, SV1, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Equinix, LLC, (Applicant) applied for a small power plant exemption for the Great Oaks South Backup Generating Facility (Application). The Committee<sup>2</sup> appointed by the California Energy Commission (CEC)<sup>3</sup> to conduct proceedings on the Application scheduled a Prehearing Conference on September 7, 2021, and an Evidentiary Hearing on September 13, 2021. The notice scheduling the Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing also set dates for the filing of opening and reply testimony. On August 24, 2021, Intervenor Robert Sarvey filed reply testimony concerning the Application (Mr. Sarvey's Reply Testimony). Mr. Sarvey had not filed opening testimony.

On August 27, 2021, Applicant filed a "Motion in Limine to Strike Sarvey Reply Testimony" (Motion to Strike).<sup>7</sup> The Motion to Strike seeks an order from the Committee

striking Mr. Sarvey's Reply Testimony. In addition to the Motion to Strike, Applicant seeks an order shortening time, specifically requesting that the Committee hear and consider the Motion to Strike at the Prehearing Conference and requests a shortened time for the filing of responses to the Motion to Strike.<sup>8</sup>

## **DISCUSSION AND ORDER**

In general, responses to motions are due within 14 days after the motion is filed.<sup>9</sup> The Presiding Member has authority to regulate the conduct of the proceeding, including the discretion to shorten the time allowed to respond to motions in a manner that preserves the parties' notice and provides an opportunity to be heard.<sup>10</sup>

Here, the fourteenth day after the date the Motion to Strike was filed is September 10, 2021. While the Committee will not consider the Motion to Strike at the Prehearing Conference, it will issue an order shortening time to resolve the Motion to Strike prior to the Evidentiary Hearing to help conduct an orderly proceeding.

The Committee therefore **GRANTS** the request for an order shortening time to respond to the Motion to Strike and **ORDERS** as follows: the parties shall file any response to the Motion to Strike no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 8, 2021. No further briefing or oral argument will be allowed.
