5 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Good morning everybody.

6 This is the Alamitos Energy Center Closed Session.

7 Basically, it's a Committee conference that's going to be

8 Closed Session today. We're in the Charles Imbrecht Room,

9 formerly known as Hearing Room B here at the California

10 Energy Commission. And this matter is Docket Number 13-AFC-

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Today we will convene a Committee meeting for the Alamitos Energy Center. As explained in our January 20th, 2016 rescheduled Notice of Committee Conference, this conference is being held for the limited purpose of conducting Committee deliberations in Closed Session.

Normally at this time I would do introductions.

But I just want to state for the record that the only people who are here right now, besides the court reporter, are the members of the Committee. And the members of the Committee are Karen Douglas, who is the Presiding Member sitting to my right, Commissioner, and Commissioner Janea Scott, who is the Associate Member sitting to my left.

Sitting to her left is Rhetta DeMesa, her Adviser, and when I say her, I'm talking about Commissioner Scott.

And to Rhetta DeMesa's left is Matt Caldwell, who is also 1 Commissioner Scott's Adviser. To my right is Commissioner 2 3 Douglas. And to Commissioner Douglas's right is Jennifer Nelson, Commissioner Douglas's Adviser. And to Jennifer's 4 5 right is Le-Quyen Nguyen, Adviser to Karen Douglas. 6 And other than the court reporter, that's all 7 who's here this morning. 8 Now, we do have Ralph Lee who is one of the 9 Hearing Office Attorneys who is managing the WebEx for us, so thank you, Mr. Lee. 10 11 With that I'm just going to describe, if you can see, if you're looking at WebEx, we've divided this agenda 12 into four parts. First, the opening meeting will be 13 14 convened, which we've now already done. Second, we will 15 take public comment. Third, the Closed Session will begin. And finally, the open meeting will reopen just to announce 16 17 the conclusion of the closed session and adjourn, and that 18 will probably be in a few hours. The closed session will be conducted in accordance 19 20 with Government Code section 11126(c)(3), which allows a 21 state body, including a delegated committee, to hold a closed session to deliberate on a decision to be reached in 22 23 a proceeding the state body was required by law to conduct. 24 With that, since we have no one in the room, I'm

just going to go directly to the phones. And I see Miles

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Muller, if you'd like to make a public comment? 2 MR. MULLER: Yeah. HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Please. This is our 3 public comment period, so you're the first one. Go ahead. 4 5 MR. MULLER: Good morning. My name is Miles I'm a student at Stanford Law School's 6 7 Environmental Law Clinic. Under the direction of the Executive Director of 8 9 the Clinic, and our Supervising Attorney Debra Seamus 10 (phonetic), I, along with several other students, will be 11 representing the Los Cerritos Wetlands Land Trust in the 12 procedure. We're looking forward to reviewing the Presiding 13 Members Preliminary Decision. 14 We believe the records and arguments made by Land 15 Trust to date make a valid case for denial of the 16 application. And we hope that the Committee's PMPD 17 recommends denial. We will be submitting comments on the PMPD once 18 19 available on behalf of the Land Trust and putting its other 20 arguments into greater detail. 21 Now, the announcement to this Closed Session discouraged public comments. I don't want to take any more 22 23 of your time today. We just wanted to make a courtesy call 24 to introduce ourselves and to let you know that we will be 25 representing the Land Trust in this matter from now on. And

1 we very much appreciate your time today. 2 Thank you. 3 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: And we appreciate yours. 4 Thank you very much for your comments, Mr. Muller, and glad 5 to have you aboard. We hope to have a Presiding Members 6 Proposed Decision out pretty soon, so that's what we're --7 that's where we are at in the flow of this process. 8 I see that we have Caller Number One. 9 MR. MULLER: Okay. Thank you. 10 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Yeah. Thank you. 11 There's another person on the telephone not It just says "Call-In User Number One." 12 identified. 13 There's nobody else on the phone. So if you are that person 14 and wish to make a comment, please speak up now. And it's possible your phone is muted. So if -- oh, is that -- oh, 15 okay. All right. I have it on good authority that that's 16 17 somebody associated with the Energy Commission. 18 So having no one else on the phone and having no 19 one else in the room, we will at this time go into the 20 Closed Session. We will be off the record, and then I will 21 come back on the record to adjourn the meeting. So we are in Closed Session. 22 23 (Whereupon the meeting of the California Energy Commission went into Closed Session at 10:08 a.m.) 24 25 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: We're back on the record

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after terminating the closed session. It is now, it looks
