## DISCLOSURE OF COMMUNICATIONS

I am employed by the Energy Commission and serve as the Commissioners' Advisor for Siting. In that capacity, I advised and assisted the Energy Commission Committee<sup>1</sup> assigned to conduct proceedings on the Application for Certification for the Alamos Energy Center in the preparation of the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD). I give notice of the following communications I had with Energy Commission staff regarding the preparation of the PMPD:

On February 12, 2017 I initiated and had communications with Matthew Layton, who is the Manager of the Engineering Office of the Energy Commission's Siting, Transmission and Environmental Protection Division. Mr. Layton supervises the Energy Commission staff that authored the Air Quality section of the Final staff Assessment, Part 2, for the Alamos Energy Center and related testimony for the evidentiary hearing. On my own initiative, I asked Mr. Layton to review the accuracy of my calculations of Power Blocks 1 and 2 and the auxiliary boiler's operational greenhouse gas emissions. I presented the calculations to Mr. Layton in a table I created through my own diligence, using data I obtained from the South Coast Air Quality Management District's Final Determination of Compliance, which is in the evidentiary record. Mr. Layton reviewed my calculations; advised me to verify my use of metric tonnes versus short tons and my use of CO<sub>2</sub> and CO<sub>2</sub>E; but agreed with my final numbers. The table I created is included in the
