**FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE CALIFORNIA  
BUILDING ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS 2022 CALIFORNIA GREEN BUILDING  
STANDARDS CODE  
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24,  
PART 11,  
And  
PARTS 2, 2.5, 3, 4, and 5  
California Energy Commission**

**UPDATES TO THE INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS:**

In response to public comment the following modifications were made to the regulation text:

- There were minor non-substantive changes to the text for numbering, grammar, and punctuation for clarity purposes.
- There was a change to Part 11, section A4.203.1.2 changing the number of prerequisite energy efficiency measures from one to a minimum of two energy efficiency measures. This change is necessary to be responsive to public commentary and is consistent with the prior requirement that specified one or two prerequisites depending on tier.
- In response to a comment, a change was made to Part 4, section 402.1 to clarify that the California Energy Code supersedes the California Mechanical Code. This change is necessary to ensure and improve the general clarity and internal consistency of the Energy Code as directed by California Government Code sections 11349 and 11349.1, and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 16.

**MANDATE ON LOCAL AGENCIES OR SCHOOL DISTRICTS:**

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has determined that this action will not result in a local mandate on local agencies or school districts.

**OBJECTIONS OR RECOMMENDATIONS MADE REGARDING THE PROPOSED REGULATION(S):**

All responses to public comments, including acceptance of recommendations and justification when recommendations were not accepted, are hereby incorporated by reference and included in the final rulemaking file.

**DETERMINATION OF ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND EFFECT ON PRIVATE PERSONS:**

The CEC determined pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.9(a)(4) that no alternative before it would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which this action is proposed; would be as effective or less burdensome to affected persons than the adoption of the proposed regulation; or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.

Except as discussed in the summary and response to comments, no alternatives were recommended.

**REJECTED PROPOSED ALTERNATIVE THAT WOULD LESSEN THE ADVERSE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON SMALL BUSINESSES:**

The CEC determined pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.9(a)(5) that the adopted regulations will not have a significant adverse economic impact on small business and no alternatives were proposed that would lessen any adverse economic impact on small business except as discussed in the summary and response to comments.
