STATUS REPORT 6

April 10, 2014, the El Segundo Amendment Committee issued a "Status Reports Including Schedule Recommendations" requiring status reports from all parties on April 25, 2014 and every four weeks after that.

On May 5, 2014, the comment period for the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) and PSA Errata ended. Written comments were received from the petitioner and Michelle Murphy, a local neighbor.

The petitioner proposed revisions to several conditions in their May 5 comments. More specifically they proposed revisions to Conditions of Certification (COCs) **BIO-9, -10, -16** and **-17** as presented in the PSA, which they state are to ensure that the COCs are compatible with the existing facility and current COCs, and also to reflect actual conditions at the site. The project owner also proposed what they state to be important changes to **BIO-9, -10,** and **-16,** and the project owner is opposed to **BIO-17** in its entirety. The project owner included no further explanation for the proposed revisions or deletions. Staff will be requesting additional information and/or explanation regarding the proposed edits included in the petitioner's comments on the PSA. Staff prepared a memo with their specific questions, and the docketing and posting of the memo to the project website is forthcoming. Answering staff's questions about these proposed revisions and deletions is necessary before staff can consider how to reply and whether to accept any proposed revisions to the Biological Resources section of the Final Staff Assessment (FSA).

On May 7, 2014, the petitioner also filed additional information for Cultural Resources Data Request 78. Staff has reviewed this information and determined that it is still incomplete. Staff outlined the missing information in a memo which was docketed on May 13, 2014. Staff requires resolution of the issues identified in the memo in order to complete the FSA. As discussed in Status Report No. 5, staff will need four weeks from the time the final information is docketed to finalize the Cultural Resources section of the FSA.

Staff is also waiting for the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) to be published by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD). Staff from SCAQMD indicated that they expect to issue the FDOC for the project by the end of June 2014. Staff will need three weeks from the time the FDOC is released to finalize the Air Quality Section and docket the FSA.
