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**STATEMENT OF STAFF APPROVAL
PETITION FOR CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP AND OPERATIONAL CONTROL
FOR THE
MALBURG GENERATING STATION (01-AFC-25C)**

On December 15, 2021, a petition was filed with the California Energy Commission (CEC) requesting to change operational control and ownership of Malburg Generating Station (MGS) from Bicent (California) LLC to the City of Vernon, Vernon Public Utilities.

MGS is a 134-megawatt combined-cycle electric generating station that was certified by the CEC on May 23, 2003 and began commercial operation in October 2005. The facility is in the City of Vernon, Los Angeles County, California.

A statement describing the change in ownership and operational control, signed under penalty of perjury by the City of Vernon, was submitted pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that the City of Vernon understands the conditions of certification in the Commission Decision or as previously amended and agrees to comply with those conditions.

Staff has reviewed the petition and has determined that the petition meets the requirements of California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1769(b). Accordingly, staff hereby approves the petition to change ownership and operational control of MGS.

This Statement of Staff Approval is being mailed to interested persons on the project mail list.

Any person may file an objection to staff's approval within 14 days of the filing of this notice. Any such objection must state the grounds for the objection. If a person files such an objection, the petition will be considered by the CEC at a noticed business meeting.
