This letter comprises the comments of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) in response to the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) regarding Commercial and Industrial Fans and Blowers.

PG&E understand the potential of appliance efficiency standards to cut costs and reduce consumption while maintaining or increasing consumer utility of products. We have a responsibility to our customers to advocate for standards that accurately reflect the climate and conditions of our respective service areas.

PG&E respectfully requests that the deadline for submitting comments to Docket Number 22-AAER-01 be extended to April 26, 2022, two weeks after the public hearing scheduled on April 12, 2022.
