The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop to present and gather stakeholder feedback on the Draft Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Infrastructure Plan (ZIP). No commissioners will be in attendance.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the direction provided below. Please note that the CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time depending on various factors.

Background

On September 23, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Executive Order N-79-20, setting a 100 percent ZEV target for new passenger vehicle sales by 2035 and 100 percent ZEV operations target for medium- and heavy-duty vehicles in the state by 2045. Many state agencies and efforts are underway to support this goal. The California Air Resources Board is developing Advanced Clean Cars II and Advanced Clean Fleets regulations to help the state achieve its climate and air quality goals. Similarly, many state agencies are coordinating efforts to support the transition to a zero-emission vehicle future for all Californians. The ZIP will support the ZEV Market Development Strategy developed by the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development (GO-Biz) in collaboration with multiple state agencies, addressing the "infrastructure" pillar of that strategy.

This workshop will seek feedback on the Draft ZIP which aims to describe the state's pathway to deploying the ZEV infrastructure necessary to support the state's ZEV adoption goals. The Draft ZIP will be published on the Events page and the Publications page on the CEC website before the workshop.
