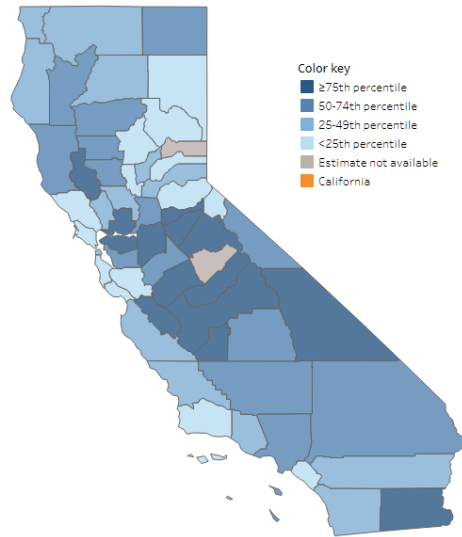
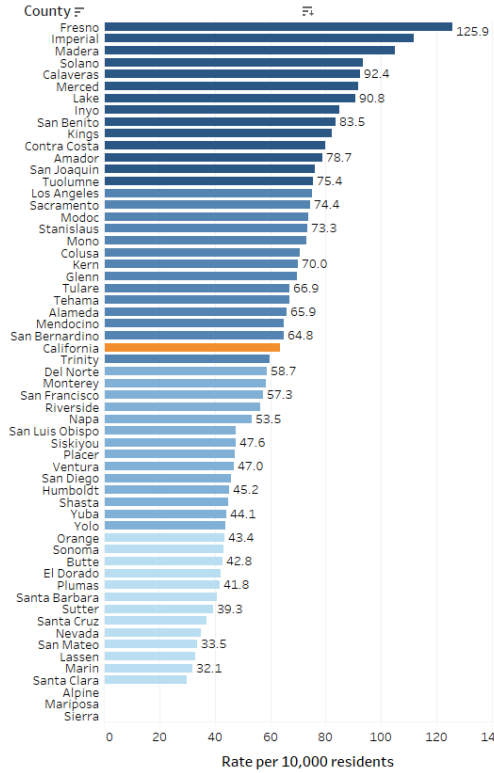

To sort the graph alphabetically by county, hold the cursor over "County" on the top left corner of the graph and click on the sort icon. To sort in the other direction, click again.
