Please note that the California Energy Commission (CEC) Committee for the application for a Small Power Plant Exemption for the STACK Backup Generating Facility intends to conduct a committee conference beginning at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, August 9, 2022 at the Warren-Alquist State Energy Building, located at 1516 Ninth Street, Sacramento, California 95814.
