## **Diablo Canyon needs to close as scheduled!**

I am strongly opposed to delaying the planned closure of the Diablo Canyon nuclear power plant.

The plant is old and unreliable. To continue operating would require billions of dollars to make needed upgrades. This money would be much better invested in the expansion of renewable energies, such as solar, wind and water.

PGE agreed to the closure 6 years ago, and is mandated to develop renewable energy sources to replace the energy currently produces by Diablo Canyon. Hold PGE to its obligations!

Nuclear power is not "clean": plant operations kill marine life, the longterm storage of nuclear waste remains unresolved, and the plant sits near several earthquake faults, making it especially risky.
