Closing Diablo Canyon was always a mistake. Sticking to this plan now would be an even bigger mistake.

Specifically:

- Diablo Canyon is a critical source of firm, clean energy. If we get more blackouts in the summers after Diablo is closed, the decision makers who elected to continue with the plans to close it will be responsible.
- Study after study shows that decarbonizing is much cheaper with firm power, instead of only variable renewables and storage. Keeping Diablo open is part of this, both directly and indirectly, by showing the country that even California has moved past our outdated anti-nuclear sentiment and now embraces the role that nuclear power can provide.

Surveys show that the California public supports this. This is a happy case where you can do the right thing for the climate, air quality and reliable electricity *with public support*. IMO, you'd be crazy not to.
