Alex,

There are 2 issues Greenheck recommends CEC consider regarding harmonization with the AMCA CRP:

1. Reporting – We’d like to have CEC accept AMCA CRP input for listing “Commercial and Industrial Fans” in the CEC MAEDBs? This would be a huge step towards:
 - a. Reducing the burden on manufacturers to submit data to both AMCA and CEC.
 - b. Eliminating confusion in the marketplace between the CEC MAEDBs and the AMCA CRP directory.

It is my understanding that CEC T20 accepts HVI CRP input for “Residential Exhaust Fans” and lists these fans in the CEC MAEDBs. See screen shot below for a listing of some Greenheck Residential Exhaust Fans. How can the same process CEC T20 uses with HVI be implemented for the AMCA CRP and “Commercial/Industrial Fans”?

2. Compliance and Enforcement – Harmonization with the AMCA CRP will bring added rigor to the T20 program in that the AMCA CRP requires periodic monitoring, testing and compliance enforcement of manufacturers published fan performance.
