## **Please let's save the Diablo Power Plant!**

The past few years have been unprecedented when it comes to climate disasters, and keeping the Diablo Plant open is one way to help mitigate them. According to a recent study from Stanford and MIT, delaying the retirement of Diablo Canyon to 2035 would reduce California power sector carbon emissions by more than 10% from 2017 levels and reduce reliance on gas. It would also save \$2.6 Billion in power system costs, and bolster system reliability to help protect against brownouts. Conversely, closing it means that the lost power will be replaced with fossil fuels, which would emit 15.5 million metric tons of additional GHG emissions between now & 2030.

Please let's do the right thing for our planet and the future! Let's keep the Diablo Power Plant open.
