California can be a global leader in fighting climate change, and keeping this reactor open is one of many solutions we can utilize in preserving a sustainable way of life for all Californians.

As a citizen of San Luis Obispo, I believe it is imperative that we keep a renewable source of energy for SLO county residents. Diablo Canyon produces 15% of California's zero-carbon energy & 10% of the state's energy. Keeping the plant commissioned will prevent blackouts for the county as well, a fact well documented by the California Energy Commission and CAISO.

Moreover, using Diablo Canyon as a power source for desalination could substantially augment fresh water supplies to the state as a whole and to critically overdrafted basins regions such as the Central Valley, producing fresh water volumes equal to or substantially exceeding those of the proposed Delta Conveyance Project.
