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NOTICE OF RECEIPT PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION CHANGE Border Project (01-EP-14C)

On August 19, 2022, CalPeak Power Border LLC on behalf of Hermes BESS LLC (owner) filed a petition for a post-certification change (TN# [245506-1](#) and [245506-2](#)) with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Border Project.

The 49.5-megawatt (MW) simple-cycle, natural gas project was certified by the CEC on July 11, 2001 and began commercial operation on October 26, 2001. The facility is located on Otay Mesa at 2060 Sanyo Avenue in San Diego, San Diego County.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The project owner seeks approval to modify the Border Project by implementing a 52-MW Battery Energy Storage System project (BESS) on the existing Border Project parcel. The project will be known as the Border BESS project.

REVIEW PROCESS

This petition is reviewed pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769. The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, or deletion of any condition of certification adopted by the CEC in the final decision or subsequent amendments is required.

After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, the assessment will be published for public review and comment. Included in the staff analysis, staff will provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a staff-approved project change or schedule it for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

This notice of receipt is being mailed to the CEC's Border project mailing list of interested agencies, the public, and property owners that requested placement on the mailing list as well as to property owners within 1,000 feet of the facility site and 500 feet of the facility linear features (for example, pipeline). The notice is also being sent to the Border Project list serve. The list serve is an automated CEC system by which information about this facility is emailed to parties who have subscribed. Any person may comment on the petition or the staff analysis when publicly available. The CEC encourages use of its electronic commenting system.
