## Communities in Charge Public Workshop

You are formally invited to attend the “Communities in Charge” public workshop in partnership with CALSTART and the California Energy Commission. Come learn about the “Communities in Charge” light-duty electric vehicle (EV) charging incentive project and the current proposed project design. This public workshop will be a great place to gather information and ask questions and will be followed by a public comment period, slides will be available prior.

“Communities in Charge” is a new block grant to help accelerate the deployment of Level 2 EV chargers, help meet the State of California's goal of 1.2 million chargers by 2030, and support rising demand from electric vehicles on the road. The initial project includes \$30 million in incentive funding, with the potential to implement up to \$250 million, based on CEC approval and future funding allocations. This project is designed to accelerate the market while considering communities across the State and incentivize EV infrastructure development in areas where we live and gather.
