Dear Mr. Hesters,

In accordance with the California Energy Commission’s Instructions for Electric Transmission-Related Data Collection, Publication Number: CEC-200-2022-004, dated July 2022, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commissions¹ provides the following statement:

“Hetch Hetchy Power’s transmission facilities are part of the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) balancing authority. Hetch Hetchy Power’s transmission system is connected into the CAISO operated transmission system and PG&E’s distribution system to deliver power to Hetch Hetchy Power customers located in San Francisco and the Peninsula.

Hetch Hetchy Power has no pending or proposed Purchasing Power Agreements outside of the CAISO service territory.”
