The California Energy Commission (CEC) staff will host a webinar to present research recommendations for the CEC's Long-Term Gas Research and Development (Gas R&D) Strategy. This strategy aims to identify research that will help achieve a net-zero carbon gas system in California by 2045.

Background

In 2004, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) designated the CEC as the administrator for the gas research fund (Decision 04-08-010), which includes surcharges from consumers who receive gas services from public utility gas corporations. The gas research fund supports public interest research and development through the Gas R&D Program.

In June 2021, the CEC began developing a study to develop a long-term research strategy to help achieve a net-zero carbon gas system in California by 2045. The strategy from the study provides research recommendations for all stages in the gas supply chain (production, transmission, storage, and distribution for low carbon fuels) and end use sectors, except for utility-scale power

generation. This webinar will present recommendations from this study that will inform future research on technology development, deployment, and demonstration in the CEC's Gas R&D Program.
