**Subject: STATUS REPORT #24 FOR THE LAFAYETTE BACKUP GENERATING FACILITY SMALL POWER PLANT EXEMPTION (20-SPPE-02)**

In its December 23, 2020, order directing parties to file Monthly Status Reports, the Committee ordered the parties to file and serve a Status Report on or before the 10th of each month.

Staff docketed Data Requests Set 6 on May 20, 2022. On October 21, 2022, the applicant docketed a technical memorandum discussing potential aeronautical impacts of the proposed project's thermal plume. CEC technical staff and representatives of the applicant met with airport planning staff on November 17, 2022, to discuss questions and concerns regarding the memorandum. At the conclusion of that meeting, the applicant agreed to provide additional responsive material, and our understanding is that this material will be docketed sometime during the week of December 12-16, 2022. Once docketed, CEC technical staff will evaluate the information to determine whether we have all the information we need to complete our analysis of potential impacts associated with the proposed project.
