Dear Mike Hartley:

On November 16, 2022, the California Energy Commission (CEC) adopted Resolution No. 22-1116-01b, which conditionally approved the California State Pipe Trades Council (CSPTC) as an Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP) for the 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (2022 Energy Code), contingent on certain requirements. This letter is to confirm that these requirements have been met.

Specifically, the conditions of approval (COA-2022-1 in the executive director's recommendation) required that CSPTC develop and implement an online database web service in compliance with sections 10-103.2(c)3H and 10-103.2(c)3I of the 2022 Energy Code. The conditions also required that CSPTC submit evidence to the CEC to substantiate its compliance with COA-2022-1 by December 1, 2022.

On November 28, 2022, CSPTC provided a full demonstration of the database and its ability to comply with the 2022 Energy Code. Therefore, CSPTC has satisfied the requirements of the condition of approval COA-2022-1 as provided in Resolution No. 22-1116-01b and is approved as an ATTCP by the CEC.
