The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to discuss and receive feedback from interested members of the public on potential light-duty electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure projects. During the workshop, CEC staff will present concepts for future funding projects.

#### **Background**

Assembly Bill (AB) 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. AB 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program through January 1, 2024.

The 2021 – 2022 Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan allocated approximately \$270 million for light-duty EV charging infrastructure from the Clean Transportation Program and the State General Fund. The 2022 – 2023 Investment Plan allocates approximately \$268 million for light-duty EV charging infrastructure from the Clean Transportation Program and State General Fund. This workshop will seek to discuss and receive stakeholder feedback on possible EV infrastructure projects which could be funded from these light-duty vehicle allocations.
