Dear Mr. Bohan,

In accordance with Public Resources Code Section 25402.1(h)2 and Section 10-106 of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards, this package of materials includes City of Glendale's proposed local ordinance requiring more stringent energy requirements than those set by California's 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Title 24, Part 6. Please find the following materials enclosed:

- **Att. 2:** Staff report to the Glendale City Council outlining the goals of the updated green building standards
- **Att. 3:** Signed Ordinance No. 5999, which adopts updates the City' of Glendale's Building Ordinance, including requirements for energy reach standards beyond Title 24, Part 6 baseline for new single family and multifamily residential, and for new nonresidential construction. This provides clear requirements that buildings be designed to consume no more energy than permitted by Part 6.
