Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS)

- Established in **2002**, is one of nation's most ambitious renewable energy policies.
- Senate Bill 100 increased procurement requirements to 60% of retail sales by 2030, with goal of achieving 100% renewable and zerocarbon resources by 2045.
- Key driver for achieving decarbonization of energy sector.
- Completed verification of Retail Sellers' Compliance Period 3 (2017-2020) procurement claims, with a **33%** procurement requirement.
