Dear Jonathan Johnson:

On January 27 and 30, 2023, National Energy Testing Institute, Inc. submitted applications to be certified as a Home Energy Rating System (HERS) provider, under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1674, and as a residential data registry, under the 2022 Energy Code. Staff has reviewed the application materials submitted to docket 22-HERS-01 and finds them to be incomplete.

For HERS provider and residential data registry applications to be considered complete, National Energy Testing Institute, Inc. should:

- Remove all mentions of sampling from the application materials.
- Remove all mentions of an External Digital Data Source from the application materials.
- List the forms that the registry will be capable of registering.
- Review and respond to each incomplete item listed on Attachment 1.

The application approval process cannot proceed until these deficiencies have been addressed and (if needed) revised application materials have been submitted to the 22-HERS-01 docket.
