# Topics covered

- **Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act**
  - Options for holding meetings post July 1, 2023.





- In-person
  - Shall be open to the public without conditions
    - At the CPUC or CEC (or elsewhere if identified in the 10-day notice)
  - ADA compliant
  - Notice of meeting/location and agenda at least 10 days in advance of meeting
  - Written materials (e.g. DACAG comment letters) must be made available to the public
  - Public are allowed to record the meeting but cannot disrupt (agencies typically provide option to listen or view the meeting remotely)
  
- Option: Teleconference (Gov. Code Section 11123)
  - Must comply with the above in-person meeting requirements
  - Each location from which a member will participate must:
    - Be identified in the 10-day notice;
    - Allow the public at a minimum to hear the meeting;
    - Allow for public participation and the receipt of public comments; and
    - Have the agenda physically posted on-site
  - Votes must be by roll call

- Option - Remote; Applicable only to advisory boards (Gov. Code Section 11123.5)
  - Designate a primary meeting location
    - Must comply with all requirements applicable to in-person meetings
    - Quorum of members must be in attendance (members participating remotely do not count towards quorum)
    - Must be identified in the 10-day meeting notice and agenda and “24-hour Notice”
    - Publicly accessible
  - Other members may participate remotely, subject to the following:
    - Not necessary to disclose in the 10-day notice
    - Notice at least 24 hours before the meeting:
      - Identify members who will participate remotely
      - Include phone number or internet website where public can access remote meeting.
      - Must be posted on website and distributed via email to those who requested notice of meetings.
    - Must be listed in the minutes
    - Not required to be publicly accessible
    - No need to post in agenda at the teleconference site
  - If remote access fails, must end or adjourn the meeting.
