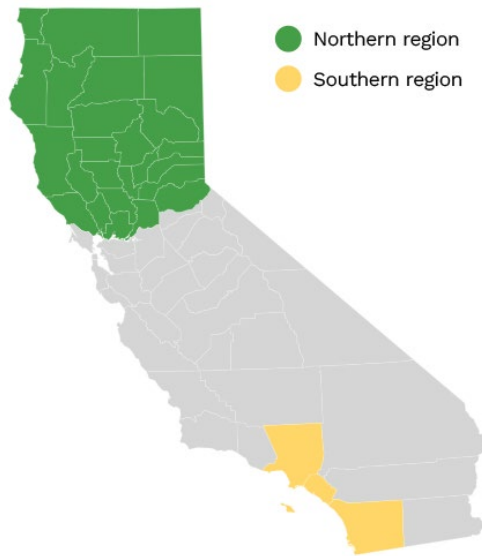
Get Ready to Apply for Rebates September 13 - November 17

Are you planning a DC fast charger installation in Northern or Southern California? You may be eligible to apply for at least \$38 million in new rebates through the [Golden State Priority Project \(GSPP\)](#).

When: CALeVIP will accept applications for funding from September 13 to November 17, 2023*.

*Note that application window dates are subject to change, pending final funding approval.

Where: Rebates will be available for publicly available sites exclusively within disadvantaged or low-income communities, per the California Climate Investments [Priority Populations Map](#).

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Updated Applicant Requirements: What You Need to Know

GSPP funding tiers have been updated.

Before the application window closes, applicants must show, **at a minimum, that they have submitted documentation to their utility service provider for final utility design** (which requires applicants to progress beyond initial application steps) **AND have applied for a permit** with their local Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ). Applicants who are further in the process of utility design and permit issuance will receive priority status for funding.

After the application window closes, applications will be assigned a tier based on the documents submitted. Once assigned to a tier, applications will be randomly assigned a place in the queue within that tier. The queue of reserved rebate funding will be awarded to tier 1, 2 and 3 in that order.

Documents Due by November 17

Tier 1	Final utility design completed AND Issued permit
Tier 2	Final utility design completed AND Permit application submitted
Tier 3	Documentation submitted for final utility design AND Permit application submitted
Conditional Waitlist	New or upgraded utility service application submitted

Applicants unable to meet minimum requirements in Tier 3 can apply for the Conditional Waitlist by submitting proof of application for new or upgraded utility service before the application window closes.

Please note that Conditional Waitlist applicants must meet Tier 3 requirements before becoming eligible for any funding applications and will only be reviewed if funding is not exhausted by Tier 1, 2 and 3 applications, or if additional funding becomes available.

Adjusted Deadlines for Upcoming Charger Requirements

The following requirement for DCFC will be in effect for this and all future funding rounds.

Requirement	Effective Date
ISO 15118 Hardware Ready (via self-attestation of “ISO 15118” or “ISO 15118 Ready” on spec sheet)	July 1, 2023

The effective dates for the following DCFC requirements have been adjusted. Applications received after these dates will be required to adhere to the listed requirements.

Requirement	New Effective Date	Original Date
DCFC Energy Star Certification (for charger models up to 350 kW)	January 1, 2024 (6-month delay)	July 1, 2023
OCPP 1.6 or later Core (Subset) & Security certifications*, or OCPP 2.0.1 certification proof of payment, or OCPP 2.0.1 test tool report showing compliance for Core & Security	January 1, 2024^ (6-month delay)	
OCPP 2.0.1 Core & Security certification*	January 1, 2025^ (New)	

**EVSE models must be certified to be eligible for CALeVIP funding. There are no current requirements for the certification of software used by the charging station management system.*

^Manufacturers that enroll OCPP 1.6 certified equipment on or before January 1, 2024, may request an extended July 1, 2025, certification deadline for OCPP 2.0.1.
