The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a staff workshop to discuss and receive feedback from interested members of the public on a draft solicitation concept for projects to support municipal light-duty electric vehicle fleet charging infrastructure.

### **Background**

Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007) created the Clean Transportation Program (CTP) to help achieve California's climate change policies and support projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector. The CTP has provided funding for a broad spectrum of zero-emission vehicles and infrastructure, alternative fuels and technologies, and workforce development projects. The CEC's Clean Transportation Program's funding will cease on January 1, 2024 unless the legislature extends it this term.

Vehicle fleets are a crucial resource for municipalities throughout California. The State of California has identified clear goals for transitioning these fleets from carbon-dependent fuels to zero-emission vehicles. To support these goals, the CEC is developing a solicitation to support electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE) related to light-duty electric vehicles (LDEV) within municipal fleets. The cost to install EVSE is often a major hurdle to fleet EV adoption. These LDEV fleets could be relevant to county, city, police, fire department, and other key vehicles that support municipalities.

This pre-solicitation workshop aims to gather feedback on concepts that would result in projects installing LDEV fleet infrastructure serving a municipality within California.
