## **Portable Air Cleaners as a strategy for this program**

Centers for Disease Control: "Portable HEPA air cleaners offer a simple means to increase the filtration of aerosol particles from a room without modifying the existing building ventilation system." Air cleaners can be effective and lower cost than repairing or replacing HVAC systems.

CDC: "Consider portable air cleaners that use high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filters to enhance air cleaning wherever possible, especially in higher-risk areas such as a nurse's office or sick/isolation room."
