# Proposed Amendments

---

- Proposed amendments to the California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 20, sections 1102, 1105, and 1221:
  - Allow the CEC to conduct business meetings as necessary,
  - Remove minutes requirement at business meetings,
  - Ensure sufficient information is provided to evaluate petitions for rulemakings, and
  - Increase the time for the executive director to respond to a petition for rulemaking from seven to 14 days.



# Benefits of the Proposed Amendments

---

- Provide the CEC more flexibility on when to hold business meetings.
- Address recurring issues in the implementation of unnecessary or obsolete regulations and save staff time and resources.
- Allow the CEC to effectively conduct the CEC's business while minimizing delays in responding to requests for rulemakings.



# Rulemaking Timeline

---

- September 22, 2023 – Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) published and public comment period began.
- October 26, 2023 - Notice of the public hearing was posted.
- November 6, 2023 - 45-day written comment period closed.
- November 7, 2023 - Public hearing to receive comments on the proposed regulations.
- November 8, 2023 - The CEC will consider adopting the proposed amendments to the regulations at its business meeting.
