Pro arguments:

- Create Construction and permanent jobs
- Benefit the County(\$)
- Enhance Fire Prevention and Protection

Job Creation:

- Up to 12 full-time jobs during project operations

Very specialized and trained plant managers and technicians. The mentioning of 12 full time jobs is laughable given the size, scope and impact of the project.

- Creates many construction jobs

Huge construction labor shortage (not like 2008-2010)

Construction industry booming in all sectors (Building, Heavy Civil, Industrial)

\$1 Trillion infrastructure bill

- Creation of jobs is a good thing, just less of a pro argument given the current conditions.

Conextgen's stated benefits of Fountain Wind

Monetary Benefits for Shasta County and Others

- \$3.5 million in sales tax revenue during construction (say \$1million/year during const.)
- \$1,000,000 for the Shasta County Sheriff's Office
- \$100,000 to the Western Shasta Resource Conservation District and Shasta County Fire Safe Council
- \$1 million investment in the Round Mountain and Montgomery Creek communities.
- \$50 million in property tax revenue over 30 years (\$1.67million/year)
- \$250,000 Pit River Tribes
 - ~ \$3.3 mil (year 1), \$2.67 mil (years 2-4), \$1.67 mil (years 5-30)
 - Shasta County Yearly Operating Budget – \$569,000,000

Equates to 1/2% - 1/3% of Shasta County's Yearly Operating Budget
Proverbial "Drop in the Bucket"

- Enhance Fire Prevention and Protection?
