## MOTION TO PARTIALLY LIFT SUSPENSION AND ORDER PARTIALLY TERMINATING SUSPENSION OF PROCEEDINGS

On June 1, 2016, El Segundo Energy Center, LLC (Petitioner) filed a *Notice to Lift Suspension* (TN 211692) with respect to their previously filed Petition to Amend for steam turbine weatherization covers at the El Segundo Energy Center (ESEC). This Petition to Amend was originally filed January 7, 2016 (TN 207213), Petitioner's request to suspend all pending Petitions to Amend related to ESEC was filed on February 18, 2016 (TN 210454), and the Committee suspended all petitions on March 8, 2016 (TN 210653). The Committee is treating the Petitioner's *Notice to Lift Suspension* as a Motion by the Petitioner, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1211.5(a).

Good cause appearing therefor, and no opposition having been filed<sup>1</sup>, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the suspension of the Petition to Amend for steam turbine weatherization covers is terminated and Energy Commission Staff shall proceed in their review of only that Petition to Amend. The suspension of the Petition to Amend for the El Segundo Energy Center Project remains in effect per TN 210653.
