Notice of Public Comment Period CalCERTS, Inc. Home Energy Rating System Provider and Data Registry Applications Docket # 22-HERS-01

The California Energy Commission (CEC) is providing interested members of the public with the opportunity to comment on the CalCERTS, Inc. (CalCERTS) Home Energy Rating System (HERS) provider and residential data registry applications for the 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Energy Code).

Background

The Warren-Alquist Act directs the CEC to establish criteria for a statewide HERS program. Home energy rating services cannot be performed in California, unless those services are certified according to the program established by the CEC. The CEC's California HERS program regulations establish requirements for home energy rating systems, providers (including the providers' training and certification of raters), and CEC certification of providers. The regulations define a provider as an organization that administers a California HERS program.

Building projects that include energy efficiency measures requiring field verification and diagnostic testing (FV&DT) must register certificates of compliance, installation, and verification through a residential data registry.^{1,2} These certificates may be used to demonstrate compliance to enforcement agencies during the building permit process.

CalCERTS, an approved HERS provider, has applied pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 24, section 10-109(g)1, for modification of its 2022 Energy Code residential data registry to incorporate low-rise multifamily compliance documents listed in the Data Registry Requirements Manual.³ A component of the application changes the provider's approved materials previously submitted under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1674(a). This revision consequently requires that the applicant's previous certification be re-certified.

Staff has reviewed and verified the residential data registry application to confirm that it is complete.

Staff plans to present a recommendation to approve the CalCERTS data registry application and provider re-certification at the January 24, 2024, CEC business meeting. If approved by the CEC, CalCERTS will be authorized to incorporate low-rise multifamily compliance documents into its residential data registry. CalCERTS will also be authorized to train, certify, and oversee raters for the 2022 Energy Code for permitted low-rise single-family residential, multifamily, and nonresidential projects using the submitted updates to its training materials.

Comments must be submitted to the Docket Unit by **5:00 p.m. on January 2, 2024**.
