But as a property manager of five RV parks in California and a board member of our statewide RV park association, it’s been known for some time that most of the RV spaces in California have long term tenancy on them. Most of the long term tenancy is one year to five years tenancy by such customers as building contractors, traveling nurses, utility linemen, and retirees. Modern recreational vehicles with their up to five slideouts and amenities have become very comfortable to live full time in and the rv space rent is affordable.

And even KOA (Kampgrounds of America, the biggest RV park franchise) encourages long term tenancy, <https://koa.com/ways-to-stay/extended-stays/>

And of course our short term customers will be driving typically a long ways to get to the RV park, and need EV charging upon arriving at the RV park.

RV parks are typically located in very public accessible locations near or on a freeway.
