The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access webinar to demonstrate revisions to CEC Form D354_I - Daily Spot Contract Report (Form D354_I) for the implementation of Senate Bill (SB) X1-2 (Stats. 2023, 1st Ex. Sess. 2023, ch. 1). The revisions split Form D354_I into two separate forms to capture the initial agreement and the settlement of the spot market deal. The revised Form D354_I also clearly states the differential between the final price and the New York Mercantile Exchange (NYMEX) for easier analysis of trading prices.

The public can participate in the webinar consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The webinar may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Staff will present the revised Form D354_I used for compliance with SB X1-2 and will demonstrate how to complete and submit the form. There will be time at the end of the webinar for questions and public comments.

Background

In March 2023, Governor Gavin Newsom signed SB X1-2, the California Gas Price Gouging and Transparency Law. This bill, along with SB 1322 (Stats. 2022, ch. 374), added to the California Energy Commission's (CEC) oversight of the petroleum industry established by the Petroleum Industry Information Reporting Act (PIIRA) of 1980 (Pub. Resources Code, § 25350 et seq.). Among other things, SB X1-2 increases transparency through new data collection and reporting, creates an independent division to monitor petroleum markets and flag potential market manipulation, and requires the CEC to assess the transportation fuels market and identify methods to ensure an adequate, affordable, and reliable fuel supply as the state transitions away from petroleum fuels. SB X1-2 added the spot market reporting requirement under 25354(I) and Form D354_I facilitates submission of required information to the CEC.
