

In accordance with Public Resources Code Section 25402.1(h)2 and Section 10-106 of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards, this package of materials includes the Town of San Anselmo's proposed local ordinance requiring more stringent energy requirements than those set by California's 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Title 24, Part 6. Please find the following material enclosed:

- Att. 2: Staff report outlining the goals of the updated Green Building Requirements
- Att. 3: Signed Ordinance No. 1181, which adopts the updated Green Building Requirements, for energy reach standards beyond Title 24, Part 6 baseline. The amended reach standards use a flexible compliance pathway as developed by the California Energy Codes & Standards Team. This also outlines the ordinance's CEQA exemption under California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §1506(b)(3).
