The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a staff workshop to discuss and receive feedback from interested members of the public on a draft solicitation concept for projects to support light-duty electric vehicle charging infrastructure in disadvantaged and low-income communities located in urban areas.

The workshop will be held remotely. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted, and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Background

Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007) created the Clean Transportation Program (CTP) to help achieve California's climate change policies and support projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector. The CTP has provided funding for a broad spectrum of zero-emission vehicles and infrastructure, alternative fuels and technologies, and workforce development projects.

Senate Bill (SB) 1000 (Lara, Chapter 368, Statutes of 2018) directed the CEC to assess EV infrastructure deployment in California. In 2020, the CEC released a staff report titled the "California Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Deployment Assessment: Senate Bill 1000 Report." The report found that there are fewer total chargers within census tracts with a high-population density and that low-income communities have the fewest public Level 2 chargers per capita.

This pre-solicitation workshop aims to gather feedback on concepts that would result in projects installing light-duty electric vehicle charging infrastructure in disadvantaged and low-income communities in urban areas.
